## **NCCCF Goals**

The Network of California Community College Foundations (NCCCF) enhances and supports the resource development capabilities of California Community College foundations through leadership, training and networking. The goals of the NCCCF are as follows:

- **Educate:** Provide resources that educate and strengthen the members of the network and our constituents.
- Collaborate: Collaborate with colleagues and other advancement professionals to identify
  opportunities, secure and share resources and develop programs that enhance the success
  of Network members.
- **Communicate:** Communicate with foundations to share information about, promote benefits of and increase participation / membership in the Network.
- Advocate: Advocate for the support of policy-makers to strengthen community college foundations.
- Operate: Provide efficient and effective systems and processes that enable the delivery of NCCCF's mission while ensuring the highest levels of regulatory and policy compliance, transparency and accountability.

## **Board Responsibilities**

The NCCCF is led by a voluntary Board of Directors, made up of seasoned professionals representing various California Community College foundations. Board members are expected to:

- Actively support the goals and objectives of the Network of California Community College Foundations.
- Actively participate in quarterly NCCCF board meetings.
- Serve on at least one of the active NCCCF committees.
- Serve as a leader and advocate for California Community College foundations and advancement.
- Promote the NCCCF and its goals throughout the California Community College system.
- Be willing to leverage personal and professional contacts to advance the goals of the NCCCF, including recruiting new members or officers, increasing NCCCF revenue, building corporate partnerships, and/or providing meaningful programming and professional development opportunities for members.
- Abide by the NCCCF Code of Ethics.
- Participate in NCCCF events and presentations.
- Support the final decisions of the NCCCF board of directors.

## **NCCCF Code of Ethics**

Each member of the Network of California Community College Foundations shall:

- 1. Pursue individual and corporate conduct that demonstrates and enhances competence and integrity in all relationships with the public.
- 2. Advance ethical concepts, methods and skills for development and related activities that contribute to the well-being and financial success of the institution served.
- 3. Strive to increase and perfect professional knowledge and skills through active participation in the Network and related organizations whose work includes the improvement of the profession.
- 4. Encourage and support educational and training programs regarding advancement and related fields.
- 5. Respect the confidentiality of information gained in the process and pursuit of the profession.
- 6. Assist, support and provide leadership as appropriate in the civic development of communities and with other not-for-profit or community based organizations.
